## Home Health Services

Our dedicated team include nurses; physical, occupational, and speech therapists; medical social workers; aides; dietitians; and wound care specialists.

- **Nursing** - Wound care, medication management, disease management, our CHF program, and clinical evaluations
- **Physical Therapy** - Therapeutic exercises, balance improvement, fall prevention, and safety evaluation
- **Occupational Therapy** - Bathroom and adaptive equipment evaluation, activities of daily living training
- **Speech Therapy** - Language skill assessments and training in cognitive and swallowing disorders
- **Medical Social Work** - Counseling, community resources, short and long-term planning, nursing home or board, and care home placement
- **Home Health Aides** - Assist with bathing and dressing activities

## Hospice

Asian Network is a licensed and Medicare-certified program that meets all professional standards, including state and federal regulations.

Hospice programs focus on comfort care and maintaining the quality of life through symptom management and support related to end-of-life.

Asian Network Hospice offers comprehensive services to the terminally ill and their families. Hospice services include registered nurses, physicians, counselors, social workers, home health aides, volunteers, spiritual counselors, and bereavement follow-up visits.

The costs of hospice care are generally covered under Medicare. The Medicare Hospice Benefit, as well as a majority of private health insurance plans, provides coverage for hospice services. The hospice benefit includes coverage for durable medical equipment and medications related to the terminal illness.



## Our Hospice Team

To fulfill Asian Network's goal to preserve the comfort and quality of life for our patients, hospice offers a wide range of services:

### **Registered Nurses:**

- Provide assistance with pain and symptoms management
- Coordinate medical equipment and supplies
- Hospice nurse on-call 24 hours, 7 days a week

### **Medical Social Workers:**

- Provide patients and families with psychosocial support
- Assistance with advanced directives and other issues related to the terminal illness

### **Home Health Aides:**

- Assist with bathing and dressing activities

### **Homemakers:**

- Provide companionship and support in a variety of ways such as running errands, shopping, reading, or providing respite to caregivers.

### **Spiritual Counselor:**

- Provide emotional-spiritual support for patients and their families
